1. **Get Well Cards** – make and decorate a get well card for a sick friend. Mail it to them or take it to them. Remember to pray for them each day.
2. **Helping Hands at Home** – do something extra at home, like helping to clear the table, do dishes, pick up stuff in the yard – ask Mom or Dad what you can do.
3. **Ministry of Helps** – rake leaves, shovel snow, clean up the yard or do something else for someone who needs help.
4. **Ministry to College Students** – pick a college student to send e-mails to and cards. Let them know they are missed and pray for them.
5. **Ministry to Military men/women** – Send cards or e-mails. Let them know they are missed and you are praying for them.
6. **Missionary Letter** – get the address or e-mail of a missionary child who is about your age and write a letter to them.
7. **Write a letter to Tinumon** – our Compassion child in India. Ask your leader for a form to write on and for an envelope. Then mail the letter.
8. **Pray for an Adult** – call or talk to any adult you know and ask them for things they would like you to pray for. Pray for them every day for at least a week.
9. **Pray for a Friend** – ask a friend for things they would like you to pray for and pray for them. Ask them how God is answering their requests.
10. **Thank You Note** – write a note to the pastor, your Sunday School teacher or your KidsLife Coach and thank them for what they are doing for you.
11. **Family Devotions** – take some part in doing your family devotions.
12. **Help your Sunday School teacher** – look for ways you can assist your teacher picking up supplies, moving chairs, etc.
13. **Invite a Friend** – Invite a friend to a KidsLife activity and introduce them to other kids in your class.
14. **Tell a Friend** – Clearly share the Gospel with a friend in person, on the phone or in an e-mail.
15. **Testimony of an adult** – Ask an adult to share with you how they came to know Jesus as their Savior.
16. **Give a Testimony** – Share how you came to accept Jesus as your Savior with an adult or a friend.
17. **Help with a church activity** – for example: a garage sale, dinner, or projects for Mission Alante, Urban Scholastic Center or Advice & Aid, etc.
18. **Help in the Nursery or Walkers class** at least three times.
19. **Sing in the Christmas Choir** (double credit for practice & performance).
20. **Take a speaking or puppet part** in the Christmas program.
21. **Brother or Sister** – help your brother or sister with homework, play a game, read a book or pray with them.
22. **Nursing Home** – visit a nursing home with your class, the choir or your family.
